How can you encourage young people to involve their local community in the realisation of their project?



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A) LEARNING TO PARTICIPATE

- Participation at personal level

Refers to the potential of young people for taking decisions at each stage of the project – encouraging to take responsibility – personal development

- Participation at community level

Refers to the contribution of young people, in terms of ideas, towards the community – giving youth a voice/ empowerment in society
